Mary Jayne Rinehart of Upper Sandusky died unexpectedly, Friday, December 25, 2015 at Wyandot Memorial Hospital at the age of 94. Born October 1, 1921 in Columbus, Ohio, Jayne was the daughter of Lawrence and Florence (Hitchcock) Bricely. She married Donald Robert Rinehart on August 9, 1947 in Marysville, Kentucky.

Preceding Jayne in death were her husband Don, son Jon David, and brother William Bricely.
