



## Mary Ann Vogel

January 19, 1931 - February 15, 2013

Mary Ann Vogel, age 82 of Newark, DE and formerly of Upper Sandusky died at the Seasons Hospice, Newark surrounded by her family on Friday Feb. 15, 2013 at 1:32 am.

She was born to Hibbert and Goldie (McFarland) Gottfried on Jan. 19, 1931 in Upper Sandusky. She married Eugene Patrick Vogel on July 29, 1950 and he preceded her in death on Nov. 27, 1965.
