Merle M. Jackman, age 76 of Upper Sandusky died at 7:00 a.m. on Sat. July 6, 2013 in the Wyandot Memorial Hospital. He was born Aug. 1, 1936 in Salineville, OH to the late Henry and Helen (Martin) Jackman. Surviving is his wife Sarah L. Korosy whom he married on Nov. 27, 1958, three sons Jim (Lorraine) Jackman, Bradenton, FL, Rodney Jackman, Fort Ashby, W VA, John (Wendy) Jackman, Delaware, two daughters Jody Bowden, Nevada, Diane Jackman, Upper Sandusky, nine grandchildren Chasity, David, Elijah, Andrew, Joshua, Jeremy, Zachary, Emma and Brooke, two great grandchildren Abigail and Conor.

He had attended John Stewart United Methodist Church.

In 1954 he joined the Army Security Agency and was assigned to Tokyo, Japan where he played for the 1956 Tokyo Bulldogs undefeated Football team, they were the Far East Champions. He was named to the All-Far East Team by "Stars and Stripes" at offensive tackle. After returning to Ohio he entered the banking field and moved his family to Euclid, Barberton and Upper Sandusky.

Mr. Jackman was a 1954 graduate of Salineville Local High School, Irondale, OH. He attended Mt. Union College where he played football and basketball, he graduated from the University of Akron with a Business Degree and

Thomas Edison State College with a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.

He had been Vice President of Commercial Savings Bank, an accountant at Westinghouse, a Comptroller and Treasurer at Wyandot Dolomite, founder of Tasty Pastry, was a Business Consultant, an Entrepreneur and taught Business at Marion Technical College and at Van Guard Technical School, Fremont, OH. He was founder of The Tropical Breeze School of Realty, Bradenton, FL where he was also active as a Real Estate Broker.

During his journey he was always active in work with the Jaycees, Masonic Bodies, Young Republican Clubs and Warrior's Youth Sports Leagues. He was awarded the John S. Andres Ohio State Award for outstanding work in the Young Republican Club of Wayne County.

His hobbies were going to sports programs and attending sporting events, he coached Hi-Y Basketball at Upper Sandusky High School, he collected old fishing lures, took fishing trips to his summer home in Wawa, Canada, and enjoyed reading newspapers.

Private funeral services will be at Bringman Clark Funeral Home on Mon. July 8, 2013 with Steve Sturgeon and Dallas Maltsbarger officiating. Burial will be in Old Mission Cemetery. Military graveside services will be held by Upper Sandusky Veterans Color Guard.
