Michael Joseph “Strutter” Kinley age 53 of Sycamore passed away with his family by his side on Friday January 6, 2012 at 8:09 p.m. at The Ohio State University James Cancer Center, Columbus. He was born on July 1, 1958 to Earl and Jane (Rall) Kinley and they survive in Upper Sandusky. He married Kristy Collins on March 25, 1995 in St. Peter Catholic Church and she survives in Sycamore.
