Michial Wayne Maltzbarger, age 79, SH 294 Upper Sandusky died at 9:26pm on Thurs. June 3, 2010 in the Wyandot Memorial Hospital.

He was born Sept. 3, 1930 in Sedalia, MO to the late John and Flossie (Randsell) Maltzbarger. He married Betty M. Young on May 10, 1953; she preceded him in death on May 29, 1988. He is survived by three sons Douglas (Sharon) Maltzbarger, Dallas Maltzbarger, Dana Maltzbarger all of Upper Sandusky, grandchildren Melissa (Joshua) White Greenwich, OH, Jennifer, David, Danial Upper Sandusky, Heather (Shaun) Smith Overton, NV, Hillary Upper Sandusky, sisters Lucille West and Ruth Wood both of CA, Grace Rush, OK, a brother Frank Maltzbarger Sedalia, MO. He is preceded in death by a sister Dorothy Gleason and a brother June Maltzbarger.

Mr. Maltzbarger was member of Salem United Methodist Church, Mifflin Twp. He graduated in 1948 from Cole Camp High School, MO. He tried out for the Kansas City Blues, the farm team for the Yankees. Mr. Maltzbarger served in the United States Navy as an Airman Storekeeper during the Korean Conflict from Feb. 15, 1951-Feb. 14, 1955. He was employed by the US Commission Co. (Heritage) for 47 years starting in Aug. 1955, retiring in Feb. 1996, but continued to work there until 2002. He then worked at the Wyandot Co. Recycling Center for 6 ½ years from 2003-2010.

He was active in his church. He enjoyed watching his sons and grandchildren participate in sports and many school activities. He enjoyed playing bingo, demolition derbies, hunting, fishing and watching the Kansas City Royals and Chiefs. Michial and his wife, Betty enjoyed raising many foster children. A Christian home and the family were very important to Michial.
