



## Orland E. "Tubby" Hankins

October 26, 1927 - June 20, 2014

Orland "Tubby" E. Hankins, age 86 of Forest died at his residence Fri June 20, 2014. He was born Oct 26, 1927 to the late Avery & Harriet (Rowland) Hankins. He married Shirley Mae Barth on Apr 24, 1948 in Greenup, KY, and she died Nov 2, 1998.

Mr. Hankins is survived by 4 sons Dennis (Sue) Hankins of Lambertville, MI, David (Sarah) Hankins, Douglas (Audrey) Hankins, and Dean Hankins all of Forest, 9 grandchildren Emily (Mark) Kleeberger, Sarah (Nick) Lindsey, Tony Askins, Nick Askins, Craig, Lindsay, Matt, Gage, and Jackson Hankins, 4 great grandchildren Will and Katie Kleeberger, Noah and Eli Lindsey, and a sister Anna Lee (David) Franer of Miamisburg. He was preceded in death by 2 brothers Everett and Donald Hankins.

He graduated from Forest High School in 1945 as Senior Class Treasurer. He received a State Farmer Degree in FFA. Mr. Hankins was a United States WWII Army Veteran First Battalion 349th Infantry Regiment. He was a life member of McVitty VFW Post 1182, American Legion Post 259 both of Forest, and Amvets Post 1994 of Kenton. He was a member of Upper Sandusky Eagles Aerie 2184, and BPOE 157 of Kenton. He held offices in the VFW 1182 and American Legion 259 at the local, county, district and national levels. He taught American Flag etiquette to students and attended Veterans Day Activities at Riverdale School.

Mr. Hankins was a member of Grant United Methodist Church. He taught Sunday School at the former York St. Church. He was a grain and livestock farmer, and did carpentry and plumbing work. Mr. Hankins was a member of Farm Bureau and York St. Grange. He was an honorary Jackson Forest Fire & EMS member. He was involved with numerous community activities especially volunteering for the Forest Tree Town Festival. He and his wife were the 1996 Grand Marshalls in the Tree Town Festival. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, and spending time with his family especially attending his grandchildrens activities.

A funeral service will be held at 10:30AM Wed June 25, 2014 in Clark Shields Funeral Home with Rev. Cynthia Morrison and Jeremy Gillfillan officiating. Interment will follow in Jackson Center Cemetery with military services conducted by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259 both of Forest.
