



Orrin G. Lust

November 10, 1916 - November 7, 2016

Orrin G. Lust age 99 of Upper Sandusky died Mon. Nov. 7, 2016 at Fairhaven Health Care Community. On Nov. 10, 1916 he was born in McCutchenville to the late George E. and Mabel C. (Brause) Lust.

He married Esther L. Berg on Mar. 9, 1942 in Jacksonville, FL and she preceded him in death on June 4, 2000. Surviving are his children Patricia Diane Lust, Farmville, VA, Robert Orrin Lust, McCutchenville, Connie Jean Koppenhafer, Cincinnati, 4 grandchildren, 2 great granddaughters, 1 great grandson, a sister Alice Hieber, Bloomville. He was preceded in death by a sister Katherine Breidenbach, brothers Luther Lust and Calvin Lust.

Mr. Lust was a member of St. Paul Lutheran Church. He graduated from McCutchenville High School, and then attended Tiffin University and Ohio Northern University

Mr. Lust was a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army during WWII. He was a local farmer.

His memberships included Lincoln Hills Golf Course Silver League, Masonic Lodge #314 of McCutchenville, Mohawk School Board Member, First National Bank of Sycamore Board Director for 30+ years. Mr. Lust served on the U.S. Commission Company (now Heritage Co-op) Board for many years, being

elected to serve as president and vice-president.
