Patricia Ann Berg, age 86 of Upper Sandusky died at her residence at 12:20PM on Thurs. Apr. 24, 2014. She was born Sept. 17, 1927 in Upper Sandusky to the late Anthony P. and Dorothy R. (Finkle) Shumaker. On Nov. 20, 1948 she married the late George H. Berg in St. Peter's Rectory, Upper Sandusky.

She loved cooking, sharing recipes, canning fruits from her fruit orchard, painting ceramics, playing cards with her girlfriends and in her later years trips to Maumee Bay and Lake Erie with her family and sisters, the annual corn roast and hayride, tea parties at her house, visits to Harrison Smith Park and Indian Mill. Patricia's grandfather, Foster Finkle was the last grain mill operator at the Indian Mill. She especially enjoyed watching her grandchildren and great grandchildren participate in all types of activities, particularly sports and music.
