Patricia Jo Cook age 71, of Findlay died at her residence on Tuesday August 21, 2012 at 4:45 a.m. She was born on June 4, 1941 in Findlay to Joseph W. and Frances E. (Hune) Shields. Patty Jo married Ronald R. Cook on June 23, 1963 in The United Methodist Church in Forest and he survives in Findlay.

She was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church, Findlay. Mrs. Cook graduated from Forest High school class of 1959. She attended BGSU and graduated with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education in 1963. She became a teacher and taught in Adams Township, Toledo; OH. Mrs. Cook directed church choirs in Frederick; MD, Bristol, CT, and Smithtown; NY where she directed two bell choirs and four vocals at First Presbyterian Church. She also taught in Parochial School in Waterbury; CT and gave private music lessons. While in Connecticut she was a charter member, a section leader and assistant director of the award winning Farmington Valley Chapter of Sweet Adelines and was a certified international arranger for Sweet Adelines. Pat was a devoted wife, mother, sister and friend. She enjoyed being

surrounded by her family and was proud of their accomplishments.

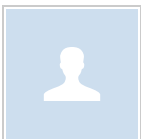
