Paul N. Hemmerly age 82 of 17865 Co Hwy 63, Forest, OH died at his residence at 9:29PM on Saturday December 15, 2007. He was born on December 5, 1925 in Forest, OH to the late Dale Hemmerly and Vanetta (Cross) Hemmerly. He married Maxine Mattix on July 24, 1946 she died on January 4, 2001.

He is survived by two sons, Gary (Sue) Hemmerly, Forest, OH, and Roger (Marla) Hemmerly, Forest, OH and a daughter, Mrs. David (Susan) Myers, Fostoria, OH and 7 grandchildren and 10 great grandchildren. Mr. Hemmerly retired in 1980 from owner/operator of the Hemmerly Family Saw Mill and was also a life-long Jackson Twp.-Wyandot Co. farmer. He served in the U.S. Navy during WWII, where he served on military amphibious personnel carriers where he transported service men from the main ships to the battle on the beach heads. He received the Asiatic Pacific Area Ribbon Three Stars, WWII Victory Ribbon, and the Philippine Liberation Ribbon Two Stars.

He was a Life Member of McVitty VFW Post 1182 and a member of the American Legion Post 259 both of Forest, OH. He served for many years on the Wyandot County Fair Board, he was past deputy of York St. Grange. He enjoyed fishing on Lake Erie and in Florida, shooting guns, and was proud of the Hemmerly family genealogy heritage.
