



Pauline L. McClintock

January 2, 1938 - April 22, 2015

IRA, Michigan — Pauline L. McClintock, of Casco, Michigan, died of cancer peacefully Wednesday, April 22, 2015 at her residence. She was 77.

Born Jan. 2, 1938 in Ann Arbor, Michigan, she was a daughter of the late L. Lawrence and Trudy Logsdon, who died in 1979 and 1992, respectively. She lived in Pontiac, Michigan, and Stow before marrying John A. McClintock in 1974 in Mount Clemens, Michigan. Her husband was a U.S. Air Force veteran and retiree from Chrysler Corp., and he died in 1999.

Mrs. McClintock is survived by a son, Robert, Warren, Michigan; a stepdaughter, Mary Lynn McClintock; and two brothers, Thomas H. Logsdon, Park Ridge, Illinois; and Timothy A. Logsdon, Dayton.

Mrs. McClintock retired in 1986 from AT&T after a 30-year career.

Her joyful life centered around her very close friends; a passion for owning, showing and sharing her pet dogs; and Gold Wing motorcycle adventures with her husband. Scrapbooks, blue ribbons and happy memories complimented her smiling conversations and quick wit.

She happily gave her time and talents in the Gold Wing Riders (Michigan Chapter A), St. Claire Kennel Club (rally obedience) and Therapy Dogs

International. Mrs. McClintock was an officer in both the St. Clair Kennel Club and McComb Kennel Club. She was proud of her 25-year award from the American Belgian Tervuren Club and membership in the Australian Shepherd Club of America.

The day after Mrs. McClintock's death, several friends celebrated her life with one of her favorite gatherings: a bonfire with grilled hot dogs, s'mores and root beer.

A funeral Mass is scheduled for 11 a.m. May 15 at Immaculate Conception Catholic Church, 7043 Church Road, Ira, Michigan. A graveside service and interment of both John and Pauline's cremains is scheduled for 10 a.m. May 16 at St. Peter's Cemetery, Upper Sandusky.
