Pudge was a Riverdale alumni and retired from Whirlpool after 40 years. After retirement, you could find Pudge supporting his grandchildren at their games and

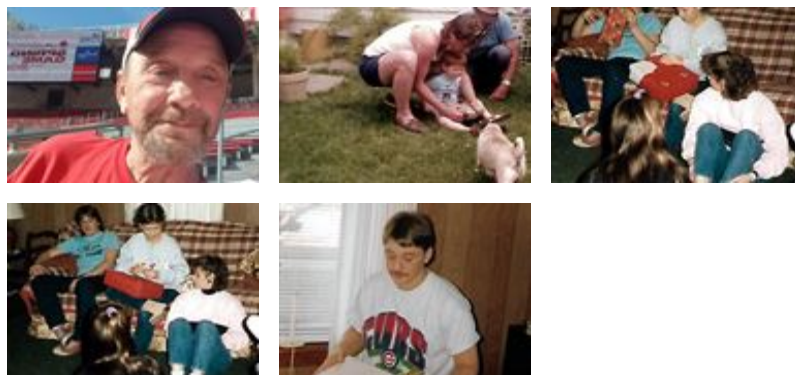
