Rev. Carl E. Harr, "Daddy Harr" age 85 of N. 7th St. Upper Sandusky, OH died at the University of Toledo Medical Center, Toledo, OH at 7:50AM on Sunday March 2, 2008 from an auto accident on CH 199, Upper Sandusky.

He was born on March 8, 1922 in Alum Bank, PA to Dennis Blaine Harr and Ida Viola (McDannel) Harr. They both preceded him in death. He married Annie C. Trefry on June 17, 1949 in Beverly MA, They moved to Ohio in Feb. of 1950 and she survives in Upper Sandusky.

Rev. Carl Harr was a Minister in North Harwich, MA, Dennis Port on Cape Cod, MA, Bellevue, OH, Roseville, OH, McCarther, OH and Upper Sandusky, OH. He retired in 1975 from the Church of the Nazarene Minister but

continued to Minster through out Ohio. Carl and his wife Annie owned and operated the Harr's Day Care Center where he was known as "Daddy Harr" to many children. He taught school in the Carey School System and subsitute taught for St. Peter's, Upper Sandusky and Carey school systems. Carl also taught Religious Ed. and was a school bus driver for area school systems.
