Richard R. Miller of Upper Sandusky, age 91, passed away February 7, 2017 at the Wyandot County Skilled Nursing Rehabilitation Center. Richard was born April 27, 1925 to the late Verlie Miller and Pearl Rutter. He was married for 66 years to Mary Lou Wall-Miller, whom passed away in 2012.

Mr. Miller is survived by two sons, Richard II (Alice) Miller of Upper Sandusky, John (Bonnie) Miller of Upper Sandusky and one daughter, Rebecca Lab of Upper Sandusky, 8 grand children and 21 great grandchildren; two brothers, Lester (Thelma) Miller, William (Ruth) Miller.
