US ARMY KOREAN WAR VETERAN

Funeral services for Richard L. Reinehr, 71, of 203 E. Clay St., Mount Blanchard, will be held at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest, the Rev. Steve Umphress officiating. Burial will be in Riverview Cemetery, Mount Blanchard, where military rites will be conducted by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both of Forest.

Visitation will be held from 2-9 p.m. Wednesday at the funeral home.

Mr. Reinehr died at 6:05 p.m. Sunday, April 30, 2000 at Blanchard Valley Regional Health Center.

He was born Nov. 16, 1928 in Columbiana to Charley and Janet (Gaundy) Reinehr. He married Lois A. Dixey on Dec. 28, 1952, and she survives.

Also surviving are two daughters, Kay Reinehr, Forest; Mrs. Robert (Dixie) Fout, Lancaster; two sons, Thomas of Redondo Beach, Calif.; William of Worthington; seven grandchildren; and a sister, Mary Janet Parkinson, Ravenna.

He was preceded in death by five brothers, Henry, Francis and three infant brothers.

Mr. Reinehr was principal at Riverdale High School from 1961 until his retirement in 1981. He also had taught and coached at Ravenna Township and Cardington high schools. A former tax preparer for H&R Block, he also operated R.L. Reinehr Tax Service, Mount Blanchard.

Mr. Reinehr served with the 5th Regimental Combat Team of the U.S. Army during the Korean War and was awarded the Bronze Star. He was a member of the Washingtonville VFW and Carey American Legion Post 344.
