Richard P. Shumaker, 80 of Upper Sandusky died at Fairhaven Health Care Community on Sat. Mar. 19, 2011. He was born Feb. 17, 1931 in Upper Sandusky to the late Anthony P. & Dorothy R. (Finkle) Shumaker.
