Robert A. "Bob" Halm age 81, of Upper Sandusky, died at the Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center on Friday Jan. 29, 2016 at 9:25pm. He was born July 19, 1934 in Upper Sandusky to Otho C. and Corrine (Black) Halm. He married Shirley B. (Young) Halm on August 4, 1971 in John Stewart United Methodist Chapel and she survives in Upper Sandusky.

He also worked for CrayCraft Trucking for 11 years. Mr. Halm was co-owner of Bob and Shirley's restaurant and Bob and Shirley's catering business. He retired from New Eezy Gro as a semi driver.

Mr. Halm was a 50 year member of John Stewart United Methodist Church.

He was a life member of Elks Lodge #83, member and past president of Upper Sandusky Lions Club, member and past Governor of the Moose Lodge #1093, member of Warpole Masonic Lodge #176 32nd Degree, Scottish Right out of Toledo and past president of Wyandot County Shrine Club. Mr. Halm was a Wyandot County Deputy for 44 years and served on the Sheriff's Auxiliary since 1962. For hobbies he enjoyed raising pure bred Arabian horses, riding motorcycles and traveling.
