



## Robert Parmelee

Robert E. Parmelee, age 82 of Valley Landing Ct., Cumming, GA died at his residence at 3:30 a.m. Sat. Mar. 8, 2008.

He was born Apr. 26, 1925 in Lackawanna, PA to the late Frank Richard and Francis H. (Dixon) Parmelee. Mr. Parmelee grew up in Barberton, OH. He married Vesta J. Fritz on June 19, 1954 in New Bremen, OH, she preceded him in death on Mar. 24, 2001 after 47 years of marriage. He is survived by sons Christian G. (Jessica) Parmelee, Cumming, GA and Clayton L. Parmelee, Hermosa Beach, CA, a sister Mrs. Don (Alice) Goodall, Scranton, PA, a brother Frank Parmelee, Cuyahoga Falls, OH, a brother-in-law Don Ross, Ashland, OH. He is preceded in death by a sister Jean Ross.

Mr. Parmelee served on a United States Navy destroyer in WW II participating in invasions of Normandy, Southern France and Okinawa. He received degrees from Heidelberg College (AB '50) (which he subsequently served on the Board of Trustees for 32 years), and Harvard (MBA '58).

Following packaging industry jobs from salesman to vice president, career positions included directing PMM and Co.'s New York Region's Marketing and Economic Consulting Services (now KPMG), and SVP and CMO for a group of Control Data/CCC Insurance and Financial Services companies. Since retirement he has consulted for SCORE (Service Corp. of Retired Executives), and prepared taxes for H & R Block.

Memberships included Fellowship Bible Church of Roswell,, GA, VFW, American Legion, MENSA and Intertel IQ Associations. He was listed in Who's Who in Finance and Industry and in Who Who's in Insurance. Mr. Parmelee will be inducted in to the Barberton, OH Schools' Academic/Career Hall of Fame in April.

Funeral Services will be held Sat. Mar. 15, 2008 at 11:00 a.m. in the Bringman Clark Funeral Home with Rev. Roy Howell officiating.

Burial will be in Bethel Cemetery, McCuthenville, OH.

Visitation will be held an hour prior to services on Sat. from 10:00 a.m.-11:00 a.m.
