Robert K. Warner, age 87 of Upper Sandusky died at 11:52 p.m. Wed. June 5, 2013 in the Fairhaven Health Care Community.

On Aug. 19, 1925 he was born in Sycamore to the late Tom and Helen (Curlis) Warner.
