Robert L. Beeler, age 61 of Upper Sandusky died on Fri. Oct. 22, 2010 at Riverside Methodist Hospital, Columbus.

He was born Dec. 21, 1948 in Hamilton to the late Steve and Jo Anne (Shollenbarger) Beeler. He married Charlene Cassel on June 28, 1975 and she survives along with son Steve, Columbus, daughter Angela, Boulder, CO, brother Henry (Ann) Beeler, Cincinnati sister Marion Stricker, Hamilton, sister-in-law and brother-in-law Cathleen and Lee Curry, Columbus, brother-in-law John Pugh, Cincinnati, 1 nephew and 3 nieces. He is preceded in death by a sister-in-law Christine Pugh.

Mr. Beeler graduated from Hamilton Taft High School in 1967 and from Princeton University in 1971. He received his Juris Doctorate from Capital University Law School in 1984 and practiced law in Carey at Cassel-Beeler Law Office.

He was a member of Transfiguration of the Lord Parish where he served as a minister of Holy Communion, choir member, Endowment Board member and served on many committees for the school and church. He was a member of the Carey Kiwanis Club, BPOE #83 where he was past Exalted Ruler in 1988, chairman of the Elks Indoctrination Committee, PER Assoc, and past District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler of Elks N.W. District in 1999, Wyandot Co. Bar

Assoc., and Knights of Columbus Council #2050. Mr. Beeler was an avid reader and belonged to the Common Readers Book Discovery Club and Friends of the Library.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held Wed. Oct. 27, 2010 at 10:00am in the Transfiguration of the Lord Catholic Church with Father Kent Kaufman officiating. Interment will follow at St. Peter's Catholic Cemetery. Visitation will be held Tues. Oct., 26, 2010 from 1:30-4:00pm and 6:00-8:30pm at BRINGMAN CLARK Funeral Home. Of course, I took a position in that business seven years later. Like Sue Hart, I remember the banana nut bread story - and actually have told it to numerous people that I have met in my life. My son, Noah, also went to Denison (lacrosse not football) and I remember meeting Charlene and Bob at the Granville Inn for drinks (for me, not for Bob) and getting a box full of papers (which I still have) from Bob on the history of Granville and Denison - more than anyone would ever want to know about either. I remember the times that Bob and Charlene met us in Philadelphia - when they were visiting friends and before the last Princeton Reunion (with Steven and his girlfriend), but what I remember most are the late night meals with Bob eating five-way Chili at a Skyline in Cincinnati (celebrating or commiserating over the events in our days), the time(s) I had to pay the entire rent on our apartment because he beat me at Gin, and the phone conversations we have had over the past 39 years - generally very late at night - during which we talked about nearly everything you could imagine. My wife, Mauri, was a participant on many of those calls - in fact, toward the end of that time, I was sure Bob called to talk to her more than to me. I talked to Bob in late October - I wish that I knew it was for the last time, because I would have said how much I loved him and how much he meant to me.
