Robert L. Stevenson, 79 of Forest, died Fri Mar 11, 2011 at his residence. He was born July 18, 1931 in Kenton to the late Ozro B. & Gladys (Hatchett) Stevenson.

Mr. Stevenson married Eleanor Sinn on May 5, 1951 and she survives. Also surviving are 1 son, Keith (Carla) Stevenson, Dunkirk, 4 daughters, Deb (Gary) Sons, Forest, Penny (Steve) Miller, Mt.
