Robert M. Bair, 76, of 17591 Township Road 64, Forest, died at 5:40 a.m. Tuesday, Nov. 17, 1998 at his residence.

He was born Dec. 18, 1921 in Findlay to William and Mary (Hasting) Bair. He married Ruth E. Miller on April 6, 1947, and she survives in Forest.

Mr. Bair was a retired farmer and businessman.

He was a member of the Ohio State and National Plowing associations, having won many plowing contests at the district and state levels.

He graduated in 1940 from Forest High School and was an honorary chapter farmer of Riverdale FFA.
