Ruth E. Kennedy age 89 a life long resident of Marseilles, OH died at Hardin Memorial Hospital, Kenton, at 4:45PM on Wednesday Feb. 24, 2010. She was born to the late Samuel Thomas and Maude (Snider) Thomas on Jan. 27, 1921 in Marseilles Twp., Upper Sandusky. She married Keith E. Kennedy on July 30, 1938, Greenup, KY, and he preceded her in death on March 4, 1987.

She is survived by two sons Tom H. (Delores) Kennedy, John L. (Carol) Kennedy, daughter-in-law Janice E. Kennedy, all of Marseilles, 8 grandchildren, 11 great grandchildren, 8 great great grandchildren, sister-in-law Margaret A. Thomas, Marseilles. She was preceded in death by a son Max A.
