Sandra F. Hemmerly age 77 of Upper Sandusky, passed away peacefully surrounded by her family on Thursday September 22, 2022 at her residence. 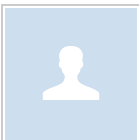

“ Where do I start.....Sandy was such a beautiful person, friendly, loving, caring, bubbly need I go on!

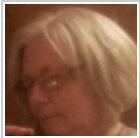
