



Schuyler Ruttmann

July 26, 1920 - October 12, 2015

Schuyler "Scotty" Ruttmann, age 95 of Upper Sandusky, died at his residence on Monday Oct. 12, 2015 at 1:10pm. He was born on July 26, 1920 in Pierre, SD to Stallard Charles and Dorothy May (Rutherford) Ruttmann. He married Elaine Amacher on Feb. 18, 1951 and she preceded him in death on Nov. 14, 2009.

Mr. Ruttmann is survived by a son James S. (Vicki) Ruttmann of Bucyrus, two daughters Janice K. (Michael) Gasser of Worthington, Julie A.
