Steven R. Reber, age 61 of Upper Sandusky died in Wyandot Memorial Hospital on Sat. Oct. 24, 2009 at 7:08 a.m.

Have faith and know that He is always with you.

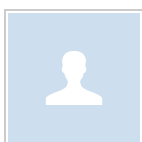

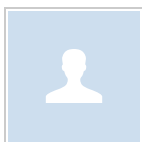
