Susan Matthew Slemmer age 89 of Upper Sandusky died Mon Jan 13, 2014 at Fairhaven Health Care Community. She was born July 15, 1924 in Bucyrus to the late Paul & Zilpah (Smith) Matthew. She married the late Charles L. Slemmer on July 15, 1951 and they later divorced.

Mrs. Slemmer is survived by her daughter Celia (John G.) Summers of Athens, son Lewis C. Slemmer of Tiffin, 7 grandchildren Graylon, Zane, Sawyer Summers all of Athens, Tyler, Hudson, Elle, Cora Slemmer all of Tiffin, a sister Molly Gamber of Upper Sandusky, and a brother Paul Matthew of Seattle, WA.

Mrs. Slemmer first attended Flora Stone Mather College from 1942-1944, and then received a Bachelor of Science in Education from Bowling Green State University. She taught at South Euclid in Cleveland, College Hill and C.A. Krout both of Tiffin. Mrs. Slemmer retired in 1987 after more than 40 years of teaching. She was a member of St. Paul United Methodist Church, Tiffin. She was very active in her church, and was a member of the Penthouse organization in Tiffin. She was an avid bridge player, and adult reading tutor. She enjoyed traveling, reading, knitting, music, theater, and spending time with her family and grandchildren. She supported any cause that benefited higher education.
