Thelma I. McCutchen, Upper Sandusky died at 5:30 a.m. Sunday Feb. 12, 2012 in the Fairhaven Health Care Community. She was 95 years old. Thelma was born on Feb. 25, 1916 she was the daughter of the late Lorin and Matilda (Enders) Courtad. On Aug. 1, 1963 she married Dean H. McCutchen and he passed away on Mar. 16, 1998.

Mrs. McCutchen is survived by her only daughter, Linda L. DeBolt, Upper Sandusky. She wore a 3 star pin everyday until her brothers Charles, Paul (P.K.) and Dale returned home safely. Although P.K. was a POW for several months

he did return home safely. Her hobbies included mowing the yard, baking cookies, watching baseball and flower gardening.
