Not only was she a devoted wife for sixty years, and a devoted mother and grandmother, she was, most of all faithful and devoted to her Lord. For many years, she was an active member of the Eagle Creek Church of the Brethren. In April, 1978, Trevabelle and her husband, Carl became chartered members of the Community Bible Church, with Robert Wood as Founder and Pastor. They enjoyed faithfully serving the Lord until being called home to Heaven.
