WW II US NAVY VETERAN

Funeral services for William C. Buxton, 78, of 16650 Township Road 86, Forest, will be held at 2 p.m. Wednesday at Heritage Christian Union Church, Forest, the Rev. Mark Bishop officiating. Burial will be in Jackson Center Cemetery, Forest, with military rites conducted by McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both of Forest.

Visitation will be held from 7-9 p.m. today and 2-8 p.m. Tuesday at Shields Funeral Home, Forest.

Mr. Buxton died at 11:55 a.m. Saturday, Aug. 8, 1998 at Marion General Hospital.

He was born May 17, 1920 in Wyandot County to William R. and Hazel E. (Haner) Buxton. He married Alice J. McNutt on Jan. 5, 1941, and she survives in Forest.

Also surviving are two sons, William A. of Forest; David N. of Radnor; a daughter, Mrs. Ray (Murna) Roach, Forest; nine grandchildren; and eight great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by a brother, George N.; and two sisters, Doris Messmer, Dayle Hemmerly.

Mr. Buxton was a retired farmer.

He was a member of Heritage Christian Union Church, near Forest, and a former member of Shiloh Christian Union Church where he was a trustee, elder and Sunday School superintendent.

He was a former Jackson Township trustee in Wyandot County. He was a former member of the Riverdale Board of Education member and the Wyandot County Fair Board.

A World War II Navy veteran, he was a member of McVitty VFW Post 1182 and American Legion Post 259, both of Forest. He was a 1938 graduate of Forest High School.
