



Wilma I. Wynkoop

March 28, 1916 - September 16, 2013

Wilma I. Wynkoop, age 97 of Upper Sandusky died at 3:25 a.m. On Monday September 16, 2013 in the Wyandot County Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Center.

She was born on March 28, 1916 in Hardin County to the late William Joseph and Alma I. (Chiles) Keith. On March 30, 1936 in Marion she married George Richard Wynkoop who preceded her in death on Nov. 27, 1996. Surviving are 3 sons Richard K. (Dottie) Wynkoop, Norwalk, Lloyd J.
