Woodrow (Woody) B. Snavelly formerly of W. Walker St., now residing at Essexway, Upper Sandusky, OH died at 4:25AM, Saturday January 3, 2009 at Wyandot Memorial Hospital. He was 88.

Born January 20, 1920 in Bucyrus, OH, he was the son of the late George Snavelly and Myrtle (Yark) Snavelly. He married Gertrude (Myers) Snavelly on Aug. 27, 1941 in Upper Sandusky and she survives.
