Zachary M. Dunn, age 60, formerly of Troy, died at his residence in Upper Sandusky of an apparent heart attack on Friday Nov. 21, 2014 at 2:13pm. He was born on Oct. 25, 1954 in Wheeling W.V. to James Jay and Geraldine (Pakle) Dunn.

He is survived by his fiance Jeanne Pelfrey his companion for the last eight years of Upper Sandusky, two daughters Jackie Lynn (Kent) Corey, North Ft. Myers, FL, Stephanie M.
